SCRIPTURE REFERENCES

Mark 12:41-44

- ⁴¹ And Jesus sat over against the treasury, and beheld how the people cast money into the treasury: and many that were rich cast in much.
- 42 And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing.
- ⁴³ And he called [unto him] his disciples, and saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury:
- ⁴⁴ For all [they] did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, [even] all her living.

Luke 21:1-4

- ¹ And he looked up, and saw the rich men casting their gifts into the treasury.
- ² And he saw also a certain poor widow casting in thither two mites.
- ³ And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all:
- ⁴ For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of God: but she of her penury hath cast in all the living that she had.
