SCRIPTURE VERSES

John 15:1-8

I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

- ²Every branch in me that beareth not **fruit** he taketh away: and every *branch* that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth **more fruit**.
- ³ Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.
- ⁴Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.
- ⁵I am the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.
- ⁶ If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast *them* into the fire, and they are burned.
- ⁷ If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.
- ⁸ Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

Romans 11:17-24

- ¹⁷... if some of the branches be broken off, and thou, being a wild olive tree, wert grafted in among them, and with them partakest of the root and fatness of the olive tree;
- ¹⁸ Boast not against the branches. But if thou boast, thou bearest not the root, but the root thee.
- ¹⁹ Thou wilt say then, The branches were broken off, that I might be grafted in.
- ²⁰Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear:
- ²¹ For if God spared not the natural branches, take heed lest he also spare not thee.
- ²²Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in his goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off.
- ²³ And they also, if they abide not still in unbelief, shall be grafted in: for God is able to graft them in again.
- ²⁴ For if thou wert cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and wert grafted contrary to nature into a good olive tree: how much more shall these, which be the natural branches, be grafted into their own olive tree?
